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THE EDUCATION SYSTEM IN SOCIAL SUPPORT OF WOMEN IN UZBEKISTAN IS AT A NEW STAGE

The article covers the reforms carried out in Uzbekistan to support women in every way, to protect their rights and interests, to realize their abilities, talents and opportunities, in a word, to have them in their education, to have their position in society.

INTRODUCTION

In Uzbekistan, which is being updated today, large-scale reforms are being carried out to protect the rights and interests of women and girls, to realize their abilities, talents and opportunities, in a word, to turn them into equal, active and creative members of society. Because, a woman is the future of the nation, the continuer of life. The women will be comfortable in the mist of a cherished, cherished land and the next. It is not said by accident that the spiritual level of any nation primarily determines the spiritual level of women of the same country. With female labor, society develops, develops fully.

After all, today in our country, the protection of the rights and interests of Women, Family, Motherhood and childhood, the provision of gender equality, the creation of new jobs for them, the improvement of working and living conditions have become a priority direction of state policy.

To create a new Uzbekistan, a wide range of innovative activities and creative work began to be carried out. President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh.M.Mirziyoyev said:" this year we will raise the level of work on the support of women and young people to a new level, " he added.

A number of legal and regulatory documents were also adopted in this regard. In particular, the decree of the president of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated 25 January 2020 and 29 December 2020 on appeals to the Oliy Majlis, the law of the Republic of Uzbekistan № 562 "on guarantees of equal rights and opportunities for women and men", the decree of the president of the Republic of Uzbekistan dated 18 February 2020 "on measures to support, decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan"on measures to further improve the system of ensuring their active participation in the life of the society "PP-5020,

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2021"on additional measures for social support of orphans and children deprived of parental care" dated 25 October 656.

At the same time, the goal was set in our country to restore the foundation of the third Renaissance. Bunda, the very first, which is the main pillar of our national idea, is the development of education, the decision-making of a healthy lifestyle, the development of Science and innovation. In achieving this goal, it is the most important task for our youth to set Great Goals for themselves, to create wide opportunities for them to achieve and to provide comprehensive support. Only then will our children become a great and powerful force that will fulfill the dreams of our people.

To modernize the country, to improve the quality of training of highly qualified personnel for Social Development, to develop human capital on the basis of the requirements of the labor market,

it is very important to increase the level of coverage with higher education, to train personnel who are creative-minded, able to make independent decisions, to create the necessary conditions for demonstrating their abilities, as well as to form a healthy competitive environment in the field. It is also not surprising that the year 2021 is called "the year of youth support and strengthening the health of the population."

By the decree of the president of the Republic of Uzbekistan on October 8, 2020, the concept of development of the higher education system of the Republic of Uzbekistan was approved until 2030. In this concept, it is also aimed to further the guarantees of the rights of girls of low-income families to higher education, to ensure the priority of the principles of gender equality in education, to carry out propaganda aimed at the broad involvement of women in higher education on a regular basis in neighborhoods, secondary schools, academic lyceums and vocational colleges, to, special tasks are set for increasing the range of educational services provided to students with disabilities and improving their quality, development of inclusive education, introduction of adaptive technologies.

Decree of the president of the Republic of Uzbekistan on measures to ensure more effective organization of the process of acquisition of rights over land parcels and other immovable property as part of the South Caucasus pipeline expansion project more ... , Indicators of admission on the basis of a state grant for women with the recommendation of the Ministry of neighborhood and family support were allocated. Also, the number of state grants for women in families in need of admission to higher educational institutions has increased by 2 times, reached 2 thousand, and special scholarships for girls who are studying for excellent grades, who need social protection are introduced.

These processes have been fully improved on the basis of Resolution No. 338 of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan "on amendments and additions to the Resolution No. 402 of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan "on approval of the Charter of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan"on the procedure for issuing According to him:

- within the framework of additional state grant-based admission indicators, the Information System "social protection unified register" of the extra-budgetary pension fund under the Ministry of Finance is connected with the inter-departmental integration platform of the system "electronic government", and the level of family needs is determined by the information on the girls of the families included in the "Iron deftar" and "women's;
- women in families in need of a referral apply electronically to the district (city) neighborhoods and family support departments at the place of residence at the place of permanent residence or temporary residence;
- documents of women in needy families who have applied for the purpose of obtaining a recommendation are accepted annually from 30 May to 8 June.

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Referring to the main criteria for determining the number of women living in needy families. They are given a recommendation based on the following criteria:

According to the decision, the first category is women in low — income families. Bunda says that a low-income family is a family with an average monthly income corresponding to each member of the family in an amount not exceeding 0,527 times the minimum wage established in the period in which the total income is determined (this amount is currently 393 thousand 828 rubles);

Next, girls in need of Social Protection, who are brought up in an incomplete family, that is, either their father or mother, or their ikkalah, also died;

Third, women in need of Social Protection, whose spouse died, raising an adult child alone;

Women in needy families who have four children with disabilities;

The fifth is the girl children of lonely women who need social protection, raising their two or more children, living separately (in rent) from other relatives;

And finallygisi, women in needy families who have one or both of their parents with first or second group disabilities.

In the established procedure, it is examined by the working group whether or not the requested women meet these criteria. The recommendation is given to all women who meet these criteria as prescribed.

According to the results of the study, a message will be sent to the mobile phone number or e-mail address of the applicants that they have been advised or rejected.

The list of women in needy families, where recommendations are given, is published on the official website of the Ministry of neighborhood and family support.

The recommendation is issued by the Ministry of neighborhood and family support in the form of an electronic document on the basis of the order of the neighborhood and family support departments of the formalized district (city), according to the final statements of the Working Group meeting.

to participate in the competition, the recommendation is given to higher education institutions for a period of one year within the framework of admission indicators on the basis of additional state grants.

Recommendations given to women and girls in needy families are sent to the district (city) neighborhoods and family support departments, and the district (city) neighborhoods and family support departments ensure that the recommendation is delivered to the applicants every year until June 15.

Starting from the 2021-2022 academic year, however, the basic payment is the introduction of the order of training from the account of the ministries of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, the authorities of the regions and The Tashkent City and state higher education institutions, the implementation of the basic payment-contract for single women who do not have parents, According to the decision of the council, it is envisaged that up to 50 women will be covered from the account of extra-budgetary funds of State Higher Education Institutions.

It is also envisaged to increase the share of women among scholarships to be sent to prestigious educational, scientific or other institutions of foreign countries by at least 20 percent after successfully completing the Bachelor's degree on the basis of scholarships of the El-yurt umidi Foundation, the Ministry of innovative development, the ministries of Higher and secondary special education.

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This plays an important role in the acquisition of educational and professional skills of women, comprehensive assistance in finding a suitable job, support for entrepreneurship, identification of young women with disabilities and the correct orientation of their abilities, improvement of living and working conditions, finding their place in society.

This law established guarantees of equal rights and opportunities for women and men in the fields of gender discrimination, direct or indirect discrimination on gender, Public Service, economic-social, education, science, culture and health on gender equality.

In conclusion, one of the priority tasks is to increase the status of women in society, to please life and to create a decent lifestyle.

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
