
**ESTABLISHMENT OF A SINGLE STATE ARCHIVE FUND IN THE
REPUBLIC OF TURKISTAN (ON THE EXAMPLE OF THE FERGANA
REGIONAL STATE ARCHIVE)**

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ABSTRACT

The article analyses archival data related to the formation and history of the State Archive of Fergana Region. It reveals information on the documents, funds and collections of the State Archive of Fergana Region. The history of the activities of the state archive of the Fergana region is an interesting page that tells about the creation of Archives, its activities - Archives, collection, storage and use of documents. Then the main part of the archive funds of the former Turkistan was the Fergana archive office. The number of works in their universities was up to 200 thousand, of which 147654 were suitable for information.

INTRODUCTION

The establishment of a single state archive fund in the Republic of Turkistan, before writing about its history, let us dwell on the archive fund. The archive fund is a set of archive documents, which are considered an integral part of the historical and cultural heritage of the peoples of the Republic of Uzbekistan, have historical, scientific, social, economic, political and cultural significance, reflect the material and spiritual life of the peoples living and living in the territory of Uzbekistan, regardless of the place, time, type of source and form of. MAIN PART

In accordance with the law of the Republic of Uzbekistan "on Archives", "regulations on the National Archive fund of the Republic of Uzbekistan" (Uz. NAF) is approved and its main purpose is aimed at ensuring full coverage of all archive documents available on the territory of Uzbekistan, maintaining the integrity of the National Archive fund of the Republic of Uzbekistan and determining the unified procedure for the compilation, registration, registration and use of archive documents in order to meet the social, cultural, scientific and other needs of citizens, The state archives of Fergana region and its branches have been established to preserve their history, modern construction and development features, to maintain, constantly replenish and use the fund of the National Archive of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the interests of the state. So let's get acquainted with what important state functions the Fergana region has in the State Archive and its branches:

- State registration and storage of documents of the National Archive fund of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
- Creation and development of scientific-reference apparatus for documents of the National Archive fund of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
- Replenishment of the fund of the National Archive of the Republic of Uzbekistan with new documents of political, national economic, scientific, socio-cultural or historical significance on the basis of expertise of its value.

- Organizational and methodical management and control over the work of departmental archives and the organization of documents in the conduct;
- Use of the documents of the National Archive fund of the Republic of Uzbekistan for political, national economic, scientific, socio-cultural purposes, as well as for ensuring the rights and legitimate interests of citizens;
- Publication of documents of the National Archive fund of the Republic of Uzbekistan in accordance with the established procedure;
- Carrying out research work in the field of archival studies, proceedings, archeology;
- Selection, placement and training of personnel.

Tasks related to the archive of Fergana region are defined in the regulations of the State Archive and its branches "on the National Archive fund of the Republic of Uzbekistan" and "on Fergana region and state branches". The history of the activities of the state archive of the Fergana region is an interesting page that tells about the creation of Archives, its activities - Archives, collection, storage and use of documents. According to the decree of the Central Executive Board of the Soviets of the Republic of Turkistan dated May 29, 1920, numbered 301, all archives of the Republic of Turkistan, state agencies as departmental institutions and files stored in them have now formed a single state. In 1920, for the Fergana region, the Office of the commissioner of the central administration of archive affairs of the Autonomous Soviet Socialist Republic of Turkestan (TASSR) was established. In the harsh conditions of the Civil War, the institution was engaged in the identification, collection and storage of documents from military units, institutions and organizations of the Fergana region in 1920-1924 years. By the decision of the Council of people's commissars of the Republic of Turkistan in 1921 year 25 January "on the regional archive funds" the following were determined:

1. All archives and proceedings located within the structure of the Republic of Turkistan are subordinated to the Central Archive Affairs Office ((Central Department of Archival Affairs), which is referred to as "Tsuardel" in subsequent places) and constitute an archive fund for each region that is included in the unified state archive fund.
2. The regional archive fund and its management are headed by the regional commissioner appointed by the Tsuardel of the Republic of Turkistan.
3. The territorial archive fund is divided into sections in relation to the division of the State Archive fund ... "[2.].

By this time, the archive fund of Fergana region was established.

From the report on the activities of the Tsuardel Commissioner's office in the Fergana region in 1922-1923 years. But it can be seen that in 1922 year the regional archives were removed from the unregulated state. In particular, large departmental archives, such as the former district governor, the former provincial governor of the former governor of the district, were somewhat regulated, though. The main archive materials of the cities were registered: the following cities took place: Skobelev (Fergana), Kokand, Andijan, Namangan, Khujand, Margilan, Jalalabad, Osh. On December 13, 1924, the decision of the Central Executive Branch of the UzSSR on the establishment of the UzSSR Tsuardel was issued, which included Tashkent, Samarkand, Fergana, that is, the storage areas of Central Acts. Then the main part of the archive funds of the former Turkistan was the Fergana archive office. The number of works in their universities was up to 200 thousand, of which 147654 were suitable for information.

In 1925, institutions under the Central Archive Affairs Department of the UzSSR were reorganized as archive posts. In 1925-1926, the archive Office of the Central Directorate of

archive affairs of the Fergana region worked. In the report of the archive bulletin from 1 October 1926 year to 1 October 1927 year, it is said that the District archive bulletin was divided into three main funds:

- Pre-revolutionary Fergana regional fund
- Revolutionary foundation of Fergana region
- Newly established fund by Fergana and Andijan districts.

There are 4 main sections in the district archives office:

- Judicial Department
- Civil department
- Military unit
- Political department

In 1927-1929, the state District of Fergana and Andijan districts was reorganized as an archive office. By the decree of the Secretariat of the executive branch of the Soviets of UZSSR on March 11, 1930 (Journal № 4/21 §1) Fergana branch of the Central Archive Department of the UZSSR was established, documents of institutions and organizations of Kokand and Andijan districts were introduced to it [3.] According to the draft resolution of the Presidium of the Central Executive Branch of the UZSSR "on the regulation of archive affairs in the UZSSR", in 1938 government proposed to the organizations of Tashkent, Samarkand, Fergana, Bukhara, Khorezm regions to choose the leading employees of the regional archive departments and coordinate their appointment with the Central Administrative Office of the UZSSR.

Fergana Regional Department of the Central Archive Department of UzSSR in Fergana city worked until 1937 year. In 1938, the Archive Department of Fergana region of the Central Archive Department of the UZSSR was established and its name was called the state archive of the region from 1940. Since 1940 year, it was established that the archives of the USSR were subordinated to the people's Commissariat of internal affairs of the USSR and the republics. Regional state archives were created [4.].

The department of the Ministry of internal affairs (in subsequent places it is called UMIA) employees of the Archive Department and the State Archive of the Fergana region, that is, attached specialists were constantly assisted in the reception, processing, registration and use of archival documents and files to the Regional Archives. But it should be noted that those who have great difficulties in providing archive buildings will come across. In 1943, the staff of the Fergana region archive and archive materials and equipment with M.Gorky Street, 52-moved to a part of the buildings located in the House.

CONCLUSION:

Since 1946, the state archives of Fergana region have been under the jurisdiction of the Archive Department of the UMIA of Fergana region, since 1957 under the Archive Department of the Department of internal affairs of the Fergana regional executive branch. The following archives of Fergana regional executive power were liquidated in order to improve the work of State Archives in Fergana region, to create archives of cities and districts by the decree of January 28, 1960: Archives of Kirov, Uzbekistan, Leningrad, Fergana, Frunzensky, Baghdad, Altirik, Okunboboyev, Kuva, Margilan. City archive in Fergana - Fergana region was given for storage of documents. The archive of the city of lamb - Kirovsky, Uzbekistan, Frunzensky, Leningrad with documents from the funds of the institutions of the districts, the archive of the city of Margilan - Akhunboboyev, Kuva, Margilan with documents from the funds of the institutions of the Margilan

districts, interarchive in Kuybishevsky (Rishton village) and the documents of the institutions of the Baghdad Regions [5].

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
