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### "FROM PUNISHMENT TO SUPPORT: A HUMANISTIC APPROACH TO DRUG LAW AMENDMENTS"

### ABSTRACT

Drug misuse is a pervasive phenomenon in Indian society and millions of Indians are dependent on alcohol, cannabis, and opiates.<sup>2</sup> In India, estimates of people using various illicit drugs run into crores: about 2 crores for cannabis, 2 crores for opioids, and 1 crore for sedatives.<sup>3</sup> About 209 million people used cannabis, while 61 million people used opioids in 2020.<sup>4</sup> In India, NDPS Act, 1985, which is enacted to curb the problem of drug trafficking and abusing of drugs, disregard the humanistic approach.
